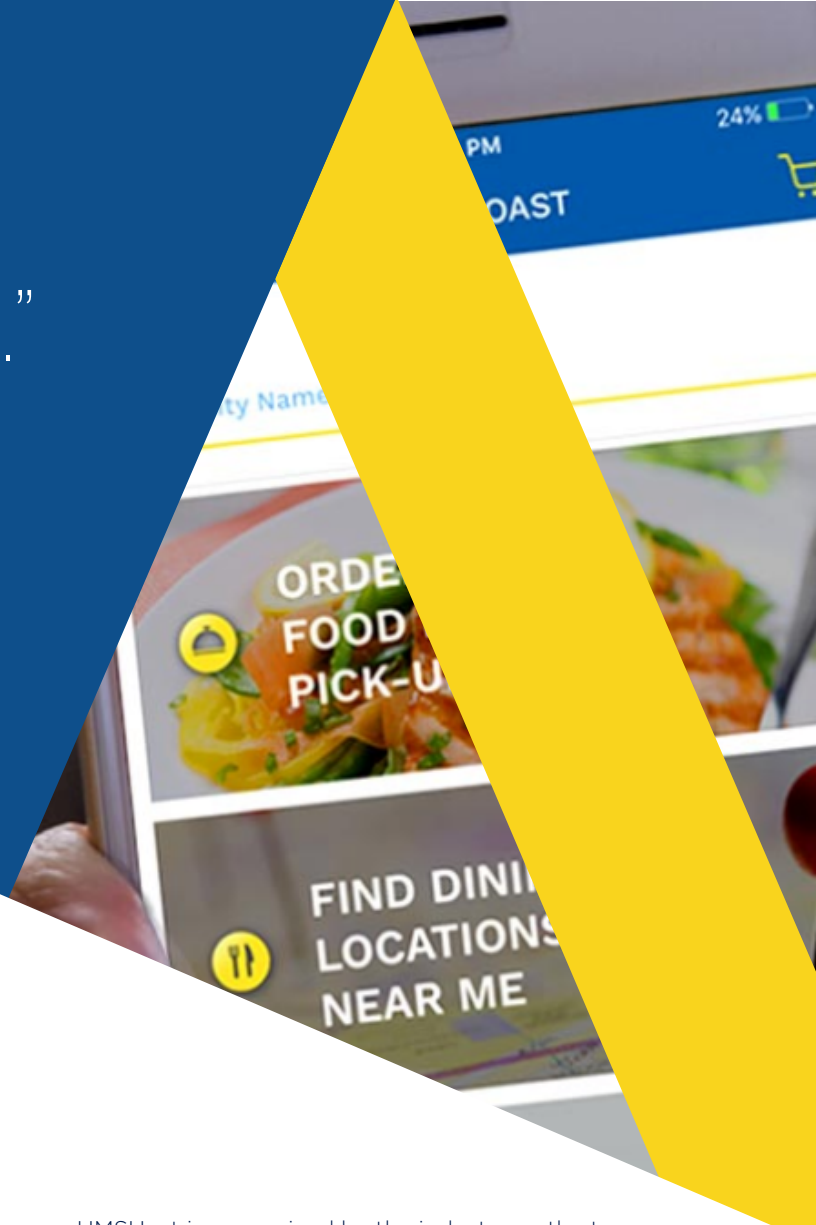
Travel dining leader HMSHost adopts PolicyHub to create a single, unified “meta” policy



## Designing a New Policy Management Framework

Global restaurateur HMSHost is a world leader in creating dining for travel venues. HMSHost operates in more than 120 airports around the globe and 99 travel plazas in North America. The company has annual sales in excess of \$3.1 billion and employs more than 39,500 sales associates worldwide. HMSHost is a part of Autogrill Group, the world's leading provider of food & beverage services for people on the move. With sales of over \$4.5 billion in 2016, the group operates in 31 countries and employs over 57,000 people. It manages approximately 4,000 stores in about 1,000 locations worldwide.

HMSHost is recognized by the industry as the top provider of travel dining with awards such as *2018 Best Overall Food & Beverage Operator* (for the eleventh consecutive year) by *Airport Revenue News*. *USA Today 10Best Readers' Choice Travel Awards* recognized HMSHost's Summer House Santa Monica at Chicago O'Hare International Airport as Best Airport Bar / Restaurant Atmosphere. HMSHost infuses innovation and culinary expertise into all aspects of its operations; with events such as the first-of-its-kind *Airport Restaurant Month* at more than 50 airports across North America, the award-winning *Channel Your Inner Chef* live culinary contest at Chicago O'Hare International Airport, and the Adrian Awards Gold-winning campaigns, *#HMSHostLove* and *Eat Well. # The Challenge

When evaluating their policy management environment, HMSHost discovered a number of challenges. First and foremost, HMSHost had not taken advantage of the benefit of having a single, consolidated location on its intranet for its employees find all policies, procedures, related forms and resources.

While the Company had an intranet where functional areas responsible for their own group of policies published them (Finance for financial policies, HR for labor and employment, IT for systems and security, etc.), the Company found overlapping policy responsibilities or ownership and policy documents.

Often, the same policy was available via many paths. It was challenging to assure that all locations were simultaneously updated and avoid having outdated versions remain available.

As HMSHost undertook inventorying existing policies, HMSHost discovered that policies and procedures did not have the same format or same defined terms. Victoria (Tori) Lang, HMSHost's Senior Manager of Policies & Procedures, put together a cross-functional team to establish a shared naming and numbering convention, uniform templates, and generally sought to have the policies reflect a common writing style.

"Understanding our current policy management landscape led to an opportunity to significantly improve policy management and eliminate inefficiencies. We faced the normal challenge of gaining top-driven support, seeking buy-in from senior management, department-by-department. Part of our success in obtaining support for policy management improvements started with a proof of concept in one functional area," said Lang.

# The Solution

"We realized that, in addition to putting a structured policy management framework in place, we needed to bring various teams and departments together. Finding a policy management solution for our organization that would work for all functional areas enabled this collaboration. On top of the labor and process efficiencies gained, we were able to contribute to a more effective compliance program with the full support of all the stakeholders," stated Lang.



By transforming their policy management framework, HMSHost drove efficiencies through their entire organization, reduced their risk and helped the company be more compliant.

# Streamlining Policy Management for Better Compliance

When HMSHost started the process of designing a new policy management framework and implementing a new policy lifecycle management solution, they had more than 120 Operations Finance policies in place. They were able to slim this down to a mere 40 policies while still maintaining strong internal controls. They also reduced and streamlined policy and procedure content from 240 pages to 90 pages, saving their associates 150 pages of reading.

Today, they continue to expand use of PolicyHub across the enterprise and are continually exploring policy change management process improvements using PolicyHub's review process, workflow design and newer template and category functionality.

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
